- Students seeking a BBA in Entrepreneurship must be declared business majors and must be eligible to file a degree plan by the close of the fall 2009 semester.

Application Process

1. Pick up an application from Room 250 of Melcher Hall, online at www.bauer.uh.edu/wce or from the Academic Advising Office.
2. Complete the application form and attach the written responses to essay questions 1 and 2.
3. Attach a copy of your unofficial transcript from the University of Houston as well as official transcripts from all previous institutions attended.
4. Submit your complete application to Room 250 of Melcher Hall (C.T. Bauer). An email will be sent to you within 48 hours confirming receipt.
5. Interview sessions will be arranged by WCE staff after an initial review of applications. You will receive your assigned date through email.

A Note on Interviews and Acceptance

The WCE Admission Committee will notify those students who pass the initial review and are eligible for an interview. All accepted students will be contacted directly and informed of their acceptance to the program.
