RED Labs Accelerator is a three-month accelerator program that provides resources for students and faculty at the University of Houston to help facilitate launching a tech startup. RED Labs offers 24/7 co-working space to startup founders, curated startup curriculum, mentorship and advising from experts in the startup community, and many more resources to help support the launch of their startup. The summer culminates in Bayou Startup Showcase, a demo day that allows startups to pitch their idea to the greater startup community.

Students may opt to receive course credit for the summer accelerator. To receive the three credit hours, the student must attend designated required curriculum and mentorship sessions and write a reflection paper at the end of the summer.

Teams must have at least one member who is a current UH student or faculty member or recent alumni; others outside the university can be a part of the team as well. These startups must apply by the last day of March at <u>redlabs.uh.edu</u>. The application should explain why the team believes there is a significant need for their startup and how they will provide a viable solution.
