DEGREE REQUIREMENTS FOR BACHELOR OF BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION – BAUER HONORS

UH & Bauer College policies (see UH Catalog for complete information and policies)

- The BBA is exclusively a daytime program for students seeking their first undergraduate degree. Post-Baccalaureate (PB) students consult an advisor for other options.
- A maximum of 66 lower-level transfer hours may be counted from any other institution of higher education.
- Last 30 hours of coursework towards a degree must be completed at the University of Houston-Main campus.
- Pre-business majors cannot take 4000-level business courses until a degree plan is filed to change from pre-business to a specific major in business. To take 3000-level business courses pre-business students must be approved for a mixed program (a one-semester transition prior to filing a degree plan) & have a 2.5 GPA or above.
- Students must file a degree plan as soon as they complete 60 total credit hours.
- Non-business majors may not take 3000-4000 level business courses with the exception of MIS 3300; INTB 3351, 3352, 3353; ENTR 3310, 3312; and MARK 3337, unless they have officially declared a minor in business or they are in a specialty program and are taking courses specifically required for that minor or specialty program. All business minors require a 3.00 GPA on the last 60 hours of coursework including transfer work and all attempted hours except for the Global Business minor and the International Area Studies (IAS) minor. A 2.0 GPA is required to take any 3000-4000 level business courses.

- **Bauer Honors students must complete a total of 18 University credit hours (6 courses) in a Bauer Honors section. 12 hours (4 courses) must be Advanced Level Business requirement courses from section 4.**

A business major with an International Area Studies (IAS) or a non-business minor may waive, with substitution, up to six hours of required advanced business electives (see Section 4, above), replacing those electives with six hours of 3000-4000 level minor courses or 3000-4000 level Study Abroad courses. A business major with a second business major or a business minor may count hours from the second business major or minor toward the advanced business elective requirements of the first business majors.
