Program Overview and Purpose

The Ted Bauer Leadership Certificate Program is a prestigious leadership program at UH, which accepts and develops 80 Bauer students each year. As a chosen cohort member, you will have the opportunity to complete leadership assessments and receive feedback throughout the program on ways you can learn and grow as a leader. The program is based upon the Leadership Challenge model outlined by James M. Kouzes and Barry Z. Posner. Upon completion of the program, each student will have a solid leadership foundation, the ability to make decisions with integrity, as well as an understanding of personal strengths and the value of working with a team.

Program Curriculum and Leadership Assessments

- **Leadership Challenge** the Leadership Challenge model and the Five Practices of Exemplary Leaders outlined by the model serves as the guiding model for TBLCP. We will review and learn more about this model throughout the year. See *Leadership Challenge* by James M. Kouzes and Barry Z. Posner.
- **StrengthsQuest** The StrengthsFinder assessment administered by the Gallup Organization will be used throughout the semester to help students identify their leadership strengths and skill areas.
- **Student Leadership Practice Inventory** SLPI is an assessment that works alongside the Five Practices of Exemplary Leaders to assess students' skills in various areas.

Program Requirements:

- Attend **all** Fall and Spring semester TBLCP Workshops
- 10 hours of community service (Fall)
- 10 hours of community service (Spring)
- Attend LifePilot Workshop (Spring)
- Complete the Student Leadership Practice Inventory
- Attend 1 Individual Coaching session with Allison each semester (30 minutes)

Attendance Policy:

All TBLCP Workshops are *mandatory* in order for students to receive their official TBLCP Certificate. No workshops should be missed without contacting Allison first. If you will be missing a workshop, please contact Allison no less than **24-hours in advance**.

If you will be missing a workshop, you will work with Allison to find an alternative workshop day you can attend with another cohort. If you're unable to attend any of the other workshop days, you must schedule a one-on-one workshop make-up session with Allison.

***Students who miss more than 2 workshops without notifying Allison ahead of time and/or making up the workshop will not receive their certificate for the program.**

Community Service Requirement:
