Program Learning Outcomes:

Through participation in the Ted Bauer Leadership Certificate Program, students will gain:

- An ability to utilize and practice foundational communication skills through exposure to public speaking, professional writing, and group communication exercises.
- A deeper knowledge of themselves through a focus on self-development and self-awareness, including I earning about their strengths, emotional intelligence, and exposure to leadership styles.
- A knowledge of professionalism and corporate culture through workshops focused on ethics, diversity, conflict resolution, and team dynamics.

Program Curriculum and Leadership Assessments

- **Leadership Challenge** the Leadership Challenge model serves as the guiding foundation for TBLCP. We will review and learn about the model throughout the year. See *Leadership Challenge* by James M. Kouzes and Barry Z. Posner.
- **StrengthsQuest** The StrengthsFinder assessment administered by the Gallup Organization will be used throughout the year to help students identify their leadership strengths and skill areas.
- **Student Leadership Practice Inventory-** SLPI is an assessment that works alongside the Five Practices of Exemplary Leaders to assess students' skills in various areas.

Program Requirements:

- Attend **all** Fall and Spring semester TBLCP Workshops
- 10 hours of community service (Fall)
- 10 hours of community service (Spring)
- Attend LifePilot Workshop (Spring)
- Complete the StrengthsQuest Assessment (Fall) and Student Leadership Practice Inventory (Spring)
- Attend 1 Leadership Coaching Session (30-45 minutes) with Allison or Graduate Asst. per semester.
- Attend the TBLCP Professional Event each semester.

Attendance Policy:

All TBLCP Workshops are *mandatory* in order for students to receive their certificate. No workshop should be missed without contacting Allison *at least 24-hours in advance*.

If you miss a workshop, you'll have two options to make it up:

- 1. Attend a TBLCP Workshop on an alternative day.
- 2. Complete 1 additional hour of Community Service

***Students who miss more than 2 workshops without notifying Allison ahead of time and/or making up the workshop will not receive their certificate for the program.**
