

## Majors Related to Business

The C. T. Bauer College of Business offers seven majors to prepare students for rewarding careers. In addition, Bauer College offers business minors and certificates open to non-business majors, as well as graduate business programs to add to a non-business undergraduate degree. The University of Houston also offers non-business degrees and majors that prepare students for careers in the corporate world, as described below.

### 1. Accounting
