Over 50,000 participants from 500 colleges, corporations and organizations have completed the program, developing a commitment to lead with integrity and to set challenging goals with a healthy disregard for the impossible.







Bauer College has offered LeaderShape for over five years, giving juniors and seniors within the college the opportunity to apply. Students are selected based on their leadership potential and focus to make change in their organizations and the community.

WHAT HAPPENS AT LEADERSHAPE?

During the six-day Institute, students participate in a wide variety of experiences to help develop their leadership skills, including a low ropes challenge course, simulations centered around the topic of leadership, small group discussions with their peers, and a guest panel of current leaders in the business community. These various experiences are designed to help students understand the value of leading with integrity and to help them create a vision for how they can make their organizations better.
