## OVERVIEW

A Bachelor of Business Administration in Supply Chain Management (SCM) will prepare you to plan and control all activities along the supply chain — a network of companies that produce, move, store, and transform materials into finished products and services for eventual consumption by the end user. SCM places a premium on effective communication, coordination, and collaboration among the supply network companies. Globalization and the rise of world-class competitors have increasingly forced companies to dramatically improve the performance of their supply chain operations in order to remain competitive.

As a result, demand by major corporations for students with specific supply chain management knowledge and skills increased substantially over the last decade. Many of these firms offer students internship opportunities prior to graduation. Starting salaries are highly competitive. Graduates in SCM now work in diverse areas, such as strategic sourcing and supply management, project management, production planning and scheduling, logistic and distribution management, quality management, and inventory and materials management. In many cases, these SCM positions are classified as “fast track” by these employers, providing graduates with rapid advancement opportunities.
