Note for Bauer Applicants:

- Students seeking a BBA degree in Entrepreneurship must be declared pre-business majors OR declared business majors.
- If you are a pre-business student, you must be eligible to file a degree plan by the close of the fall 2012 semester.

Note for Non-business Applicants:

- Students who are not business majors can be admitted into the Wolff Center

- Non-business majors will receive "The Wolff Center Certificate in Entrepreneurship" if
 they are admitted to the Wolff Center for Entrepreneurship and complete all required
 courses, but would still need to complete the requirements for their non-business major
 to graduate from the University of Houston.

- **3.** Attach unofficial transcripts from University of Houston as well as other schools attended.
- **4.** Submit your complete application to the Wolff Center for Entrepreneurship in Room 250 of Melcher Hall. An email will be sent to you confirming we received it.
- **5.** Interview sessions will be arranged by WCE staff after an initial review of applications. You will be notified via email.

A Note on Interviews and Acceptance:

The WCE Admission Committee will notify those students who pass the initial review and are invited for an interview. Interviews will not be granted at the request of the applicant. All accepted students will be contacted directly and informed of their acceptance to the program.
