

RISK MANAGEMENT AND INSURANCE TRACK

OVERVIEW:

The Risk Management & Insurance (RMI) Track gives students the essential skills they need for managing a business: the ability to identify possible risks and find the best strategy to manage them. The program provides foundational business skills for students on a wide range of career paths.

Students who successfully complete the program will receive a BBA in Finance with a certificate in Risk Management & Insurance.
