## **DEGREE REQUIREMENTS FOR BACHELOR OF BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION – BAUER HONORS**

- Daytime and Post-Baccalaureate Limitations: The BBA is exclusively a daytime program for students seeking their first undergraduate degree.

- \_\_\_\_\_ Complete the UH Core and college requirements listed under Section 1 with a passing grade
- Complete each Pre-business course under Section 2 with a grade of "C" or higher
- Complete STAT 3331 under Section 3 with a passing grade
- Clear the Business Writing Evaluation (BWE), and if required, the Business Writing Tutorial (BWT)

Students must file a degree plan by the end of the semester in which they complete 45 or more credit hours. **Students who transfer to UH with 45 or more credit hours must file a degree plan by the end** of their first semester at UH, unless an exception is approved by UBP.
