### DEGREE REQUIREMENTS FOR BACHELOR OF BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION – BAUER HONORS

- Daytime and Post-Baccalaureate Limitations: The BBA is exclusively a daytime program for students seeking their first undergraduate degree.
- Bauer Honors students must complete a minimum of 18 credit hours (6 courses) of business honors coursework; 12 Hours (4 courses) must be advanced level business requirement courses from section 5.
