RECIPROCAL EXCHANGE

Students from a Reciprocal Exchange Partner university can study at the University of Houston while paying tuition to their home university. Reciprocal Exchange Programs (REEP) provide an opportunity to take courses with local students and are best suited for highly motivated, independent students. REEPs are typically a semester or year-long commitment.

ELIGIBILITY

Eligible students must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5 or approval of the Program Director, meet the English Language Proficiency Requirement for the University of Houston, and be nominated by their home university.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS AND DEADLINES

Nominations must be received from the Reciprocal Exchange Partner Institutions by October 1 for the Spring term and June 1 for the Fall term. Before starting an application to University of Houston, send an email to the *UH Learning Abroad office* at *learningabroad@uh.edu* with the following information: *Name, Home University, and Department or College where you intend to take courses*. You will need approval from your home university and from UH before being considered for a reciprocal exchange. SAFETY AND SUPPORT
